RESULT OF THE SALE BY TENDER OF UP TO £2000 MILLION OF 0% TREASURY GILT 2026

The United Kingdom Debt Management Office ("DMO") announces that the tender of up to £2,000 million of 0% Treasury Gilt 2026 (ISIN Code: GB00BL68HJ26) has been allocated as follows:

(Note: all prices in this notice are quoted in pounds and pence)

- All bids which have been accepted at the lowest accepted price have been allotted 77.6744% of the amount bid for.

Competitive bids made at prices above the lowest accepted price have been allotted in full. Competitive bids made at prices below the lowest accepted price have been rejected.
